HOW YOUR DONATIONS HELP

Our efforts help horses and veterinarians in three primary ways:

- Scholarships for equine veterinary students.
- Education for AAEP members and their clients.
- The coordination and funding of equine research.

Since 1994, the Foundation has allocated over \$1 million to support education, outreach and research.

GIVING PROGRAMS

The Foundation's work is funded by several giving programs, including:

- Single gifts (one-time gifts)
- Annual giving (dues renewals, annual gifts)
- Planned giving (annuities, wills, trusts, estate planning)
- Honor giving (to honor a person)
- Memorial giving (to memorialize a person)
- Equine memorial giving (to memorialize a horse)
- Special event giving (auction donations/purchases)
- Special program purchases



One hundred percent of all donations directly help horses and veterinarians. Funds are distributed as soon as possible so that donors can see the fulfillment of their active participation and support. The Foundation is a 501(c)(3) organization and all donations are tax-deductible. Because the AAEP pays for the Foundation's operating costs, all contributions can be used to support programs, not administrative expenses.
